What is the purpose of TXPAC?

Keeping members and their families informed on the key issues that affect our future.

Rallies, news conferences, advertisements, and phone banks to build support on issues of concern to working people.

Voter registration, and financial support for political candidates who will stand up for working families.

PAC Contributions vs Union Dues

TXPAC funds are voluntary contributions raised to assist candidates running for office who are favorable to the BLE&T, railroad labor in general and the industry.

Retirees

The TXPAC fund works for retired members and their spouses living in Texas, by working on current issues which may affect them.

BLET PAC vs TXPAC

TXPAC contributions are used in Texas primarily for Texas issues and State and Local elections. BLET PAC funds are used for National Elections and issues.

We're fighting for you in Austin on issues that affect job security, wages, working conditions, safety, family and health.

You can help by contributing to TXPAC, the Texas Political Action Committee Fund.

Railroads and other large corporations are continually working for legislation that helps their bottom line and at the same time pushes the rights and safety of the worker further into an abyss.
